# Being God's House

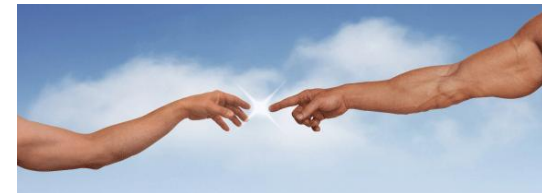
